Other Questions

All interview guides are tailored to the interviewee's role (e.g., Commander, Patrol Officer, Detective, SANE, Victim Advocate). In general, the interview questions cover the following range of topics:

- Describe your current role and job duties.
- Describe your role in the response and investigation of sexual assault.
- What training and educational opportunities does your agency provide for personnel who respond to sexual assaults?
- How are crime scenes and items of evidence in sexual assault cases managed?
- Describe your communication and interact with internal units including the sex crime investigations unit and patrol.
- Describe areas in sexual assault response that your agency/unit does well.
